## LEADERSHIP NOMINATIONS SOUGHT

Community Leadership is seeking applications for its twenty fourth class. Training sessions are provided for current and emerging leaders who live, work or volunteer in low to moderate income communities and who have demonstrated a commitment to service. Individuals who work with agencies or programs, which affect these neighborhoods, are also encouraged to apply.

The objectives of Community Leadership are to:

- Strengthen the capacity for leadership at the grassroots level.
- Create a learning atmosphere, which crosses economic, social, racial and demographic lines.
- Acquaint participants with formal and informal decision-making channels.
- Challenge and motivate individuals to become more involved in community affairs.

Thirty participants will be chosen from the Knoxville-Knox County area representing various community, civic, religious, professional and educational groups. Key factors in the selection process will be interest and demonstrated community commitment of each potential participant. The chosen will be asked to commit one (1) day each month to the ten month training program.

Community Leadership will begin with an opening reception on Tuesday evening, September 13, 2011, and a full day retreat on Tuesday, October 4, 2011. November 2011 through June 2012 training sessions have been scheduled on the 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday of each month. Sessions for October 4 will be from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and November 1 and June 5, will be from 8:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m., with lunch provided. Sessions for December 6, January 3, February 7, March 6, April 3 and May 1 will be from 8:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.
