

# Project Help Information Sheet

Project Help buys electricity, natural gas, kerosene, coal, heating oil, and wood for families who can't afford to heat their homes.



- The program is funded by volunteer donations that provide heating cost assistance to citizens in Knox, Grainger, Union, Anderson, Loudon, Blount, and Sevier counties.
- This program is administered by the Knoxville-Knox County Community Action Committee.
- The elderly and disabled on low fixed incomes are the primary recipients, but low-income families with emergencies may also qualify for the program.
- 100 percent of all funds collected goes to assist families.
- Last winter 735 families were helped through Project Help.
- Last winter volunteer donations totaled \$124,950.
