

**Knoxville-Knox County Community Action Committee
Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Goal for FY 2012-2014**

Knoxville-Knox County Community Action Committee (CAC) will continue to have a goal of 3.4% of Federal financial assistance expended in DOT-assisted contracts in federal fiscal years 2012-2014 (exclusive of Federal Transit Administration funds to be used for the purchase of transit vehicles) to be spent with firms who are certified as Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) under Department of Transportation regulations (49 CFR part 26). The proposed goal and the entire DBE program document are available for inspection during normal business hours at CAC's main office for 30 days following the date of this notice. CAC and DOT will accept comments on the goals for 45 days from the date of this notice.
