Spring is here and your garden awaits!

When you apply at your Neighborhood Center for vegetable seeds and plants, you may pick up your

seed packets at that time. Your plants will be available at the Neighborhood Centers for pick up on the dates listed in the blue box. **What kind of plants will you receive?** 9 red tomatoes, 3 yellow tomatoes, 6 bell peppers and 3 hot peppers. You also will receive a 5lb. bag of fertilizer. **What kind of seeds will you receive?** Spring crop seeds include: radishes, swiss chard, carrots, simpson lettuce, peas & mixed greens. Summer crop seeds include: bush beans, okra, beets, squash & cucumber. Whether you garden at home in containers, in a small plot or would prefer to garden in a community garden, your harvest will be well worth your efforts! For more info on open spaces in gardens,
